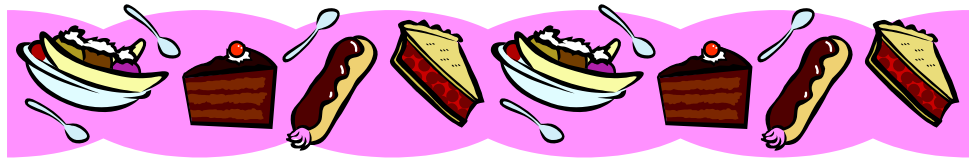
Those of you who couldn't make it, don't despair! We have plans in the works to hold 2 more Dessert Hours!

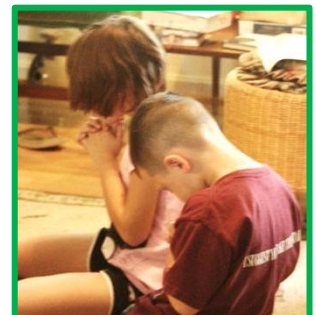
